WHAT IS THE GRPA STATE SWIM MEET?

The GRPA State Swim meet is the final competition for Georgia's youth recreational swimmers. Swimmers' ages will range from 7 years old to 17 years old. These swimmers compete at their local level, and if successful, these swimmers will advance to the state competition.

SWIM MEET DETAILS

The State Swim meet is projected to bring 5,000 swimmers and spectators into our community for the meet. The swimmers and families will begin to arrive on Thursday, July 15th, and stay until Saturday, July 16th, or Sunday, July 17th. The location of the meet - Gilbert-Stephenson Park
